Why Muslims?

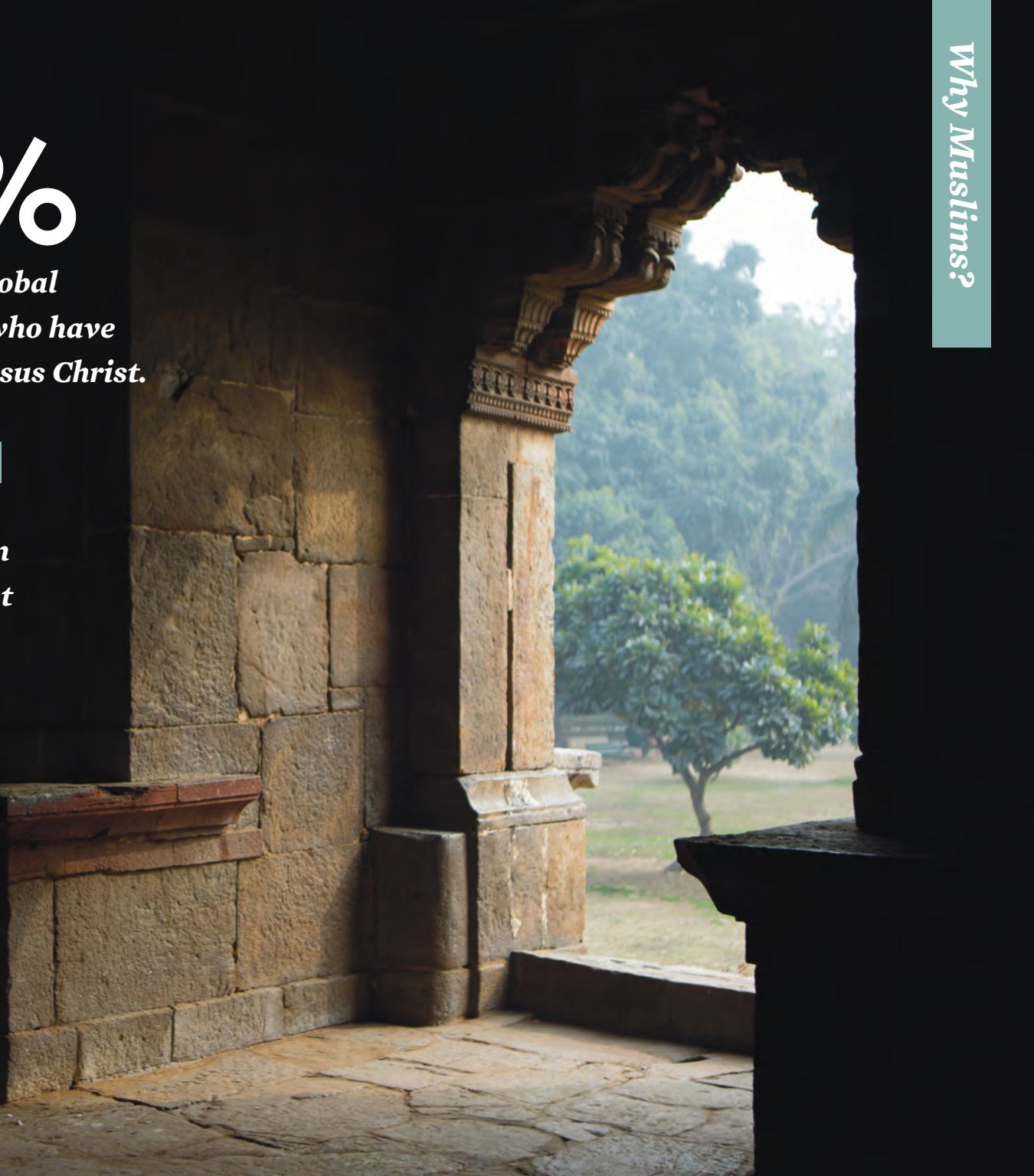
Because everyone needs Jesus.





Only *3%* of global workers go to those who have never heard about Jesus Christ.

There are only **four** missionaries per **one million** people in regions with the least access to the Gospel—like the Muslim world.
