Workshop Descriptions:

Track: Movements

Title: FAITHWORKS: Worship Beyond the Pew (OM - Operation Mobilization)

This workshop examines how authentic worship extends beyond traditional Sunday services into everyday work. Drawing on the biblical narrative of Creation, Fall, Redemption, and Restoration, participants will explore how their vocational efforts are integral to God's broader mission. We will delve into the connection between calling, character, and contribution, addressing common barriers to integrating faith and work, especially in contexts where this integration feels disconnected or discouraged. Practical tools like the VCJF cycle and Peace Index will be introduced to help participants see their vocations as spaces for spiritual growth and tangible impact. This interactive session promises honest conversations, collaborative learning, and a renewal of purpose in our daily occupations.

Title: Engaging the Next Generation (Cru)

Come and hear insights, tips, stories, and strategies for preparing the next generation of missionaries. This workshop is designed to explore the generational impact of passing on the assignment of the Great Commission.

Title: Africa, The Awaiting Frontier – The R-400 Movement (The Park Church)

This session will focus on the Continent of Africa. In this workshop we'll touch on the impact and opportunity missions work can bring to the continent (Faith, Economic and Resource) development. Education, Demystification of beliefs, Complexities, Challenges and opportunities. Beyond the opportunities we'll highlight what R-400 seeks to accomplish over the next 400 years under the 4 R's (Reconnect, Reconcile, Rebuild, Reclaim). Sample projects and initiatives that can offer opportunities to see significant impact with coordinated resourcefulness.

Track: Cultural Transformation

Title: Foundations of Cultural Fluency (TMS Global)

Learn how various cultural perspectives shape worldviews. Discover strategies for understanding and honoring cultural nuances in missions settings.

Title: Adaptive Leadership for Trends, Transition, and Transformation (TMS Global)

Understand how to stay ahead of cultural and societal shifts that affect local and global ministry.

Title: Vision Casting & Movement Multiplication (TMS Global)

Learn to articulate a compelling vision for kingdom impact; and explore methods for replicating and sustaining Kingdom movements within multi-ethnic contexts that lead to discipleship and multiplication.

Track: Long- Term Missions

Title: Why Long-Term Missions Still Matters (Ambassadors Fellowship Inc.)

Is long-term missions still relevant in this generation? In this foundational session, we'll explore the biblical mandate for long-term missions, draw lessons from historical movements, and discuss

why long-term commitment remains essential for any healthy missions strategy. Discover why sustained presence, discipleship, and relationship-building are vital—and how African Americans have a unique and powerful role to play.

Title: “Am I Called? Discerning the Call to Long-Term Missions” (Ambassadors Fellowship Inc.)

How do you know if you—or someone in your church—are called to long-term missions? This workshop unpacks different perspectives on calling, helping you recognize and respond to God’s leading with clarity and courage. We’ll explore what calling can look like, how to nurture it within the local church, and what to do when the call seems unclear or delayed. Perfect for individuals, mentors, and ministry leaders alike.

Title: “Making It Work: How to Prepare, Send, and Support Long-Term Missionaries” (Ambassadors Fellowship Inc.)

This hands-on session tackles the *how* of long-term missions. How do individuals prepare—spiritually, emotionally, and practically—for the field? How can churches effectively send and care for missionaries for the long haul? And what ongoing support systems are needed to ensure fruitfulness and faithfulness? Whether you’re preparing to go or helping others get there, this workshop will provide practical strategies, real-life insights, and a roadmap for sustainable long-term missions.

Track: Pastors & Leaders

Title: Changing the Missions Mindset of your Church (Boundless Ministries Inc.)

How do you break stagnation and the obsession with internal concerns in a congregation. Is it possible to engage the entire congregation in mission’s ministry? Come here insights on how to transform your church from an audience into an Army of Global Workers ready for the harvest.

Title: Leadership Chat – Let’s Talk Missions from a Leadership Perspective (SIM)

A Chat with SIM USA President, Randy Fairman about the moving Pastors and Leaders into missions and how to prepare workers effectively.

Title: Christians Sent by Churches (SIM)

The local church has the mandate to disciple and send Christians to make Jesus known. Expand your knowledge and your church’s ministry potential as SIM USA President Randy Fairman shares key benefits of partnering with a mission sending agency to **launch** and **sustain** global workers and why it is important for African Americans and other peoples of color to “go and tell”.

Track: Missions for Beginners

Title: Biblical Basis of Mission (Worldventure)

In the workshop we will present from Genesis to Revelation about God’s heart for the nations, and it will conclude with practical steps to move forward.

Title: Shaped For Your Calling (TEAM)

What is your story, and how does that shape your calling? As we review the background and life of the Apostle Paul, you’ll have a chance to reflect on and map your cultural and spiritual formation. How has God been preparing you, and what might that mean in discerning your calling?

Title: Developing Missions Mindset in a Selfie World (Boundless Ministries Inc.)

In a world focused on self promotion, pride, and social movements based on personality how to you move believers from being self-concerned to purpose driven with the mission of God. Want to learn how to move people from “me” to “we” for the Kingdom of God, come and hear insights in developing a missions mindset.
